

IDEAS FOR MAKING ONLINE CHURCH FUN FOR FAMILIES WITH YOUNG KIDS

1

GIVE YOURSELF GRACE

Allow yourself to make adjustments. Remember it's digital, so do what works best for your family. Give yourself grace if your online viewing doesn't work out the way you had expected. Was the experience a big flop? Don't beat yourself up - tweak and try again!

GRAB A PENCIL AND PAPER

Ask young children to draw a picture of what they are thinking during the sermon. You may want to ask older children to write down a point from the service they understood, or a question about something they did not understand. Talk about these responses any time after you watch the service.

GET ACTIVE!...AND REPLENISH!

Turn up the volume during worship! Encourage your children to add motions to the songs. Plan for your family to eat breakfast or a hearty snack during the actual sermon.

PRACTICE GIVING

Make or select a family offering container. Leave the weekly offering in the container and watch the offering grow each week. Bring it back when we return!

BRING CHURCH TO LIFE!

Create a special "church" space with selected toys where little ones can play during the sermon. Use chairs, pillows, whatever you want for walls. They may only play in this special space once a week!

6

GET CRAFTY!

Before Sunday morning create a Sunday Surprise Sack (make up your own name if you want). The bag should contain basic art supplies, playdoh, crayons, scissors, and glue. You can even throw in a "surprise" each week!
