## BOLD FOR CHRIST

With the onset of COVID-19 and the cancellation of all onsite activities, we sought to be responsible stewards by ensuring the lights were off, thermostats were turned down, and appliances were unplugged. In this time, volunteers helped to keep the grounds mowed and maintained as we focused our efforts toward online engagement.

## BOLD FOR OUR NEIGHBOR

During the COVID-19 season, the building was closed but ministry did not stop!

### GET HELP / GIVE HELP

We started a new program where 57 volunteers delivered food, household products, hygiene supplies, and prayed for 271 people in quarantine.

### FACEMASK DONATIONS

We made hundreds of facemasks and delivered them to our local healthcare facilities.



### FOOD PANTRY

We adapted to a drive-through approach where 167 families received food & prayer without leaving their vehicles.

### KOKOMO RESCUE MISSION

We assisted the Kokomo Rescue Mission with their "Grab-and-Go" food trailer.

### NORTH KOKOMO CAMPUS

Floor plans were finalized and construction drawings are now underway!

### CAR CARE MINISTRY

This incredible ministry donated 3 vehicles and repaired numerous others.



