<u>General Summary of Duties</u>: Work within a team to create environments with excellence where people feel welcomed and valued as they take their next step with Christ.

Duties and Responsibilities (includes but is not limited to):

- Carry & cast the vision of Crossroads while caring for the grounds and buildings of Crossroads.
- Support all the organization's values
 - Worshiping God is a big deal
 - All people matter to God
 - It's ok to not be ok
 - We are blessed to bless
 - We become more like Jesus together
 - We build faith at home
- Taking ownership and responsibility of Crossroads' buildings, property, and maintenance equipment to honor God and the people who have entrusted us with it's care.
 - Keeping inventory and logs of maintenance performed, equipment, and materials
 - Taking inventory of cleaners and other supplies and submitting requests when items need to be replenished.
 - Understanding of cleaning techniques and safety procedures.
 - Maintain clean church facilities by performing weekly duties and daily spot cleaning in all public areas of the buildings, including bathrooms, auditoriums, kitchens, and meeting rooms.
 - Working with other facility team members and church staff to ensure that all areas are cleaned and stocked with necessary items.
 - Observing proper chemical handling procedures when working with cleaning agents, including wearing gloves, goggles, or masks and following written or verbal instructions.



- Plan and coordinate snow removal
 - Ensure all entry/exits are clear and operable for daily operations
- Communicate daily with Facility Director about issues and agenda
- Assess and execute minor building repairs and paint projects
- Respond to building occupants' requests for service and maintenance
- Evaluate and coordinate plumbing, electrical, and HVAC repairs.
- Perform basic electrical jobs
- Clean and perform routine maintenance on HVAC systems
- Stay current on safety measures for fire, carbon monoxide and other alarms
- Work with and maintain tools and equipment necessary to perform work duties
- Help evacuate the building or facility in case of an emergency
- Perform routine inspections to identify areas in disrepair
- Coordinate and conduct corrective maintenance to identified issues
- Set up / Take down for events
- Perform floor maintenance- Scrub & Shampoo
- Other duties as required.
