

RACE FOR PLAY “*FACT SHEET*”

We need your help to raise funds for our new commercial playground!

Race for Play is an annual jog-a-thon, which involves students walking or jogging around a 1/4 mile area for one hour. This jog-a-thon program has successfully raised between \$100.00 and \$200.00 per student and sometimes more.

We are looking to raise money for playground equipment, fence to surround the area, a poured rubber foundation, and picnic area for families. Our playground will include play areas for ages 2-5 and 5-12. When not in use by the daycare, the play area will be open and available for public use. The play area will be handicap-accessible and will include ADA-compliant equipment.

The success of **Race for Play** is based on students supplying names of people who are potential sponsors for the jog-a-thon.

There is no “house-to-house” sign-up of potential sponsors. We are asking you to choose one or more of these options:

- ❖ Share our Facebook post on your Facebook page
- ❖ Supply us with your email address so we can send you the official letter to forward to friends and family.
- ❖ Fill in a label sheet of names/addresses: Potential sponsors may be family members, relatives, close friends, and neighbors. Special emphasis should be placed on out-of-state relatives and friends. Also, the people you do business with are a great source of names, i.e., barber, dentist, doctor, piano teacher, etc.

Remember for every 15 names that a student brings in, our school should receive at least \$100.00 in contributions. We will mail a one-time letter with information about our daycare and how to provide a donation either online or by mail to those on the label sheet.

Our **Race for Play** will be held Wednesday, June 29, 2022, 10am-2pm. We are planning a day of fun: jog-a-thon, picnic lunch, bounce house, Kona Ice. You are invited to join us for all the activities. More details to come.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING OUT LABEL SHEET

1. We are giving each student a label sheet, which needs to be returned with the names of people who are potential sponsors. Additional label sheets are available. *These names will not be used for any other mailings from our daycare.*
2. The student's name should be printed on the first label in the top left-hand corner only.
3. PLEASE PRINT NEATLY IN BLACK PEN directly on the label: the name, address, and zip code of each prospective sponsor. IMPORTANT: Make sure that all the information fits on one label and is legible.
4. The labels must be returned to the daycare no later than **Monday, May 16**. We will then be sending letters to the individuals on the list asking them to sponsor your child in this year's **Race for Play**.
5. Potential sponsors may be family members, relatives, close friends, and neighbors. Christmas card lists are a great source for these names. Special emphasis should be placed on out-of-state relatives and friends. Also, the people you do business with are a good source of names, i.e., barber, dentist, doctor, piano teacher, etc. Please note that if a couple is living "under the same roof," you must list them both on **one label** (i.e., Mr. & Mrs. John Doe) not two labels. *Don't forget to list your own name.* 😊
6. In order to simplify the **Race for Play**, all mailings will be sent from the school.
